Art Show is open to all students in grades K-college in public, private, parochial or home school in Bismarck-Mandan, North Dakota.

Registration deadline is March 1, 2018 and can be found at www.accartshow.com. You will be able to change/edit your registration information up until the due date by contacting Sheila Gilbertson at sheila@accartshow.com or 701-426-8722.

Limit one entry per student. No limit on number of entries per teacher or per school.

Artwork Must...

- have been completed from August 2017 – March 2018.
- have a Christian theme. Christian themes are not limited to Bible stories and may include any God glorifying witness of the Christian faith.
- be the original work of the student. All mediums accepted. 3D pieces must have appropriate supports or stands. Dimensions should not exceed 16" x 20" including mount, mat, or frame but exceptions may be made by contacting ACC.
- **have proper hanging device** on the back of artwork to hang on pegboard hooks. No saw tooth hangers and no hangers attached with tape. Framed works must have wire hangers. Unframed two-dimensional pieces must be mounted with stiff backing to stand upright.
- **be labeled with the specific ACC labels.** You may make copies of the label sheet. They are also available on our website to download. Only the student's name and grade will appear on the front of the art work. Please do not change the size of the label we have given you. Place the label at the lower right corner of the art work as shown in the example on label page.

ACC reserves the right to accept or reject any pieces.

Drop-off work: Thurs March 15 between 3-7pm. Deliver to Trinity Lutheran Church's Community Room.

Pick-up Work: Saturday, March 17 between 5-7pm (unless other arrangements are made prior to event).

Works must remain on exhibit for the duration of the show. No individual art work will be released early. Art work and certificates of participation will be returned only to the authorized student or representative/teacher. The student or representative/teacher must provide at check-in the name of any other individual authorized to pick up art. Please arrange for pickup of art; we will not be responsible for art forgotten at the event.

Certificates of participation will be given to each student.

Liability:

While ACC will take great care in handling the entries and will provide security for their protection during display, ACC does not provide insurance. It is up to the student or parents/guardians to seek insurance for loss or damage as they deem fit.
