Carrying God in Our Hearts

Rebecca Young-Sletten, instructor

Students will create a unique painting with a cross in a heart, using watercolor. A mat will be provided for each piece to have it ready for a frame.

Coffee Painting

Susan Boyce, instructor

Using real coffee, students will paint distinctive images, revealing layers of "latte" color.

Colorful Prayer Bracelets

Katie Schafer, instructor

Students will make a fun and colorful "Lord's Prayer Bracelet" to help guide and remind them to lift all their needs of daily life to Jesus. They also learn how different colors can symbolize certain ideas and thoughts.

Hamsa Symbol Hands

Alicia Broxmeyer, instructor - Apple of His Eye Art Studio

Learn how hands were used as symbols in ancient times. Create your own Hamsa hand drawing including symbols to show what's important in your life. Use Sharpies to decorate with patterns and embellish with gold and silver!

Leather Cross Key Fob

Chip Leibel, instructor

Students will stamp & dye a leather cross key fob adorned w/ silver concho.

Painting Through Nature

Kimberly Wetzel, instructor

Students will explore their connection to God's creation through painting a landscape. Various mark-making techniques will be demonstrated using acrylic paints. Inspiration will come from students' feelings and emotions when they experience nature.

Styrofoam Block Printing (morning sessions only)

Gary Way, instructor

God imprints His image on us both physically and spiritually. The human face is easily divided into thirds emphasizing that we have the Divine image imprinted in our faces. Students will draw a partner's face, transfer this to a Styrofoam plate and then print it with ink.

Create your own yarn painting (afternoon sessions only)

Jessica Humble, instructor - Traveling Artist

The Huichol Indians of Mexico are known for their yarn paintings. The Huichols take beeswax which they melt in the sun, and spread it over a piece of wood. They then push coloured yarn into the wax to create images. We will be using pieces of sticky backed laminate flooring and colorful yarn to create beautiful works of art.
